TOUR BOOKING, PARTICIPATION AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY

1. Items required to reserve your spot on the SCMR2020 include:
 - 1.1. Full Name and Address of Participant.
 - 1.2. Agreement with all Terms and Conditions.
 - 1.3. Passport numbers and expiration dates for all non-USA passport holders.
 - 1.4. Booking deposit of \$500.00 tendered online or by check or other agreed upon method
2. Booking Form
 - 2.1. Submitted online at www.CentennialRide.com _or_
 - 2.2. Requested by from Email from Info@WomensMotorcycleTours.com, printed, signed, and mailed with your deposit check to:

3. With your signature on the SCMR2020 Booking form or the Release and Waiver of Liability you agree to these Terms and Conditions as a binding contract between you and Women's Motorcycle Tours (WMT). All persons participating in the SCMR2020 are required to accept and sign a Photo Release plus a Release and Waiver of Liability form as a condition of participation.

TOUR PARTICIPANT'S REQUIREMENTS

1. Riders must have and carry a valid driver's license with proper motorcycle endorsement.
 - 1.1. The license must be valid in the state/country of residence and be endorsed for the type and size of motorcycle being ridden in the event.
 - 1.2. An international driver's license is required for participants from outside of North America.
2. Experience
 - 2.1. At least 3,000 miles of recent motorcycle riding experience is required.
 - 2.2. MSF course completion is recommended for all riders and required for riders with less than two years experience and/or 3,000 recent miles.
 - 2.3. Those with fewer than 3,000 miles of riding experience should contact Women's Motorcycle Tours prior to booking.
3. Minimum Age
 - 3.1. Rider: 25 years of age or older.
 - 3.2. Exceptions can be made on an individual basis by contacting WMT and acquiring a written exemption to this rule. Ask for details; it will depend on local laws and event insurance.
 - 3.2.1. 18-25 year olds may be allowed upon approval & on their own machine with a responsible relative/mentor also participating (or in the case of a rental motorcycle wherever the rental agency's cut-off age applies)
 - 3.3. Passenger: Ask for details, it will depend on the laws and circumstances in each state.
4. Maximum Age
 - 4.1. Riders and passengers over age 75 must have a doctor's signed health certificate on the medical office's letterhead that confirms the fitness of the individual on file with Women's Motorcycle Tours prior to the SCMR2020 start.
5. Medical Conditions
 - 5.1. If a SCMR2020 participant has a medical condition that could affect their or other's participation in the tour they are requested to notify WMT in writing before the tour. Conditions such as, but not limited to, diabetes, heart conditions, taking blood thinners, and/or severe allergies should be reported as well as any other conditions which could require special treatment or knowledge in the case of an emergency.
6. Personal gear required for SCMR2020 participation
 - 6.1. Helmet - DOT approved - Per insurance regulations, participants are required to wear helmets even if we are riding through individual states which do not require them
 - 6.2. Motorcycle Apparel – for your protection and comfort (Jacket, Gloves, Pants, Boots, Raingear).
7. SCMR2020 participants are expected to adhere to traffic laws, the WMT Terms and Conditions, and WMT's group travel rules. Participants must follow the direction of WMT tour guides. Non-compliance can result in expulsion from the tour in which circumstance no refunds of monies paid to WMT are refundable.

8. WMT cannot accept any SCMR2020 participant without a duly signed tour booking form, release and waiver of liability form and, if applicable, a doctor's signed health certificate. A copy of the release and waiver form and terms

and conditions are available on the www.CentennialRide.com web site and can be provided upon request by WMT.

RESERVATIONS AND PAYMENT

1. Deposit for reservation
 - 1.1. Deposits are due upon booking reservation to hold your place on the SCMR2020. The deposit is \$500 with the balance due ninety (90) days before tour start.
 - 1.2. You will receive your tour participation confirmation after all information requested and deposit amounts are received.
 - 1.3. Payment in full of all SCMR2020 fees is due 90 days prior to tour start date.

INCLUDED/NOT INCLUDED IN TOUR PRICE

1. What's included in the SCMR2020 registration:
 - 1.1. Ride Guides.
 - 1.2. Self-guided participants are pay as you go.
 - 1.3. Tour Book & Info Packet for each rider.
 - 1.4. Lodging and meals as stated in the detailed experience description.
 - 1.5. Women's Motorcycle Tours reserves the right to make changes of any nature, including services provided, due to unforeseen circumstances even after the tour reservation and deposit are received.
 - 2.1. All incidentals, alcoholic refreshments, minibar charges.
 - 2.2. Travel to tour start location.
 - 2.3. National Park fees.
 - 2.4. Highway tolls.
 - 2.5. All personal expenditures.
 - 2.6. Alcoholic Beverages.
 - 2.7. Fuel.
 - 2.8. Lunches (except if noted in detailed tour information).
 - 2.9. Dinners only for Fully-Guided Riders are as stated in the detailed experience descriptions
2. What's NOT included in the tour price:

ROOM ALLOCATION

Single rooms are available for an additional fee. Single rooms are available at most of our lodgings and should be requested on your SCMR2020 application. When those numbers are limited they will be allocated on a first-registered, first-served basis. For registrants selecting double occupancy on their

registration forms Women's Motorcycle Tours will attempt to find a roommate for you, but cannot guarantee one will be found. If Women's Motorcycle Tours cannot match you with a same sex roommate, the surcharge for a single room will be added to the total event fee due.

USE OF OWN OR BORROWED/RENTED MOTORCYCLE

Women's Motorcycle Tours is not responsible for the condition or safe use of a motorcycle provided by a SCMR2020 participant for use on the tour, whether owned or borrowed by the participant.

1. You are expected to arrive at the SCMR2020 start with a well maintained motorcycle in a condition to complete the SCMR2020 in a safe manner.

2. The motorcycle you choose to ride in the event shall conform to all applicable laws, be properly licensed and insured. Liability insurance on your motorcycle is required for participation in the SCMR2020.
3. You must abide by the general terms, rules and conditions while you are riding with the SCMR2020 group and on any motorcycle on the SCMR2020.

BAGGAGE

Women's Motorcycle Tours assumes no responsibility for loss, damage or delay in delivering baggage to SCMR2020 participants. Baggage turned over to WMT for transport each day is done so at each participant's own risk. Baggage insurance is recommended and can be purchased separately. Information regarding this maximum will be provided upon request and/or be addressed within the SCMR2020 information package.

WEATHER CONDITIONS

Though we strive to schedule tours in each area during the time of year most conducive to good motorcycling weather, the SCMR2020 is wrapped around and historical event, the timing of which cannot be changed. During this event we ride through many diverse geographical areas and the weather can change drastically from one area to the next. Please prepare yourself, your passenger and your motorcycle for every type of weather possible.

CANCELLATION &/OR NO SHOW BY TOUR PARTICIPANT & REFUND POLICIES

1. Because most of the accommodations and partner experiences on the SCMR2020 are prepaid well in advance of the event, cancellations will be refunded. Suitable substitutions (which participants are to find themselves) are possible up to fourteen (14) days before tour start and must be submitted in writing.
2. If the participant cancels or curtails their travel for any reason once the SCMR2020 commences, Women's Motorcycle Tours is not required to refund any monies.
3. Women's Motorcycle Tours is not required to make refunds of any kind if a SCMR2020 participant does not show up on time for the tour start. This is true for all reasons including but not limited to civil unrest, war (declared or undeclared), war-like situations, terrorism, epidemics, natural disasters, adverse weather or road conditions, fire, bureaucratic situations, changes in transportation schedules (air, ground, rail or water carriers) or the indisposition of the participant. It will be up to WMT to decide when, and where, if at all, a participant may join the group if the participant does not arrive on time.
4. If a participant's bike becomes disabled there will be no refunds.
5. If the SCMR2020 participant does not comply with traffic laws, SCMR2020 requirements for group travel or his/her riding behavior jeopardizes his/her own safety or that of any other participant(s), their participation in the event may be cancelled by WMT and the participant may be expelled from the tour. In this case the participant is responsible for any and all costs associated with their expulsion and there is zero liability on WMT's behalf.
6. Women's Motorcycle Tours highly recommends the purchase of trip cancellation insurance for all tours.

CANCELLATION AND TOUR CHANGES BY WOMEN'S MOTORCYCLE TOURS BEFORE TOUR START

Up to 30 days prior to the SCMR2020 start WMT can cancel the event if an insufficient number of tour participants have booked and fully paid by that time. In this case, the customers will be notified in a timely manner. WMT will offer to operate the SCMR2020 if all customers agree to a supplemental charge due to the low number of tour members. If customers do not accept to pay the supplement, WMT will refund their payment in full, which will constitute the full settlement.

WMT will not be liable for any additional costs or losses incurred by the SCMR2020 participant due to WMT's cancellation of the tour due to lack of participants. This includes, but is not limited to, the cost of pre-paid travel tickets, hotel reservations and auto or motorcycle rentals. We suggest purchasing trip insurance this is and many other reasons.

WMT reserves the right, without prior notice, to withdraw any part or all of a SCMR2020, to make such changes as

necessary to protect the safety of the participants and the integrity of the event.

If WMT cancels the SCMR2020 due to any situation beyond the control of WMT (force majeure) which can be, but is not limited to, civil unrest, war, war-like situations, terrorist activity, epidemic situations, natural disasters, adverse weather or road conditions, fire, bureaucratic obstacles or changes by any type of travel company, organization or government department, WMT will refund customer payments in full and exclude all additional claims.

If, due to unforeseen situations, in WMT's opinion it is necessary for us to cancel, advance or postpone the SCMR2020 tour, change itineraries or make substitutions regarding hotels, cities, tour guides and other travel arrangements, we do not assume responsibility or liability for any resulting disappointment, losses, expenses or inconvenience.

PASSPORT, CUSTOMS, VISA, DRIVING AND HEALTH REGULATIONS

WMT assumes that customers know that for traveling abroad it is necessary to be in the possession of valid travel documentation including, but not limited to, passport, visa and necessary health records applicable to the tour they are participating in.

SCMR2020 participants riding a motorcycle must have and be in the possession of a valid driving license and/or

international driving license with the proper motorcycle endorsement for the type and size of motorcycle being ridden on the tour.

WMT holds that the participant is responsible for complying with above regulations and all consequences resulting from non-compliance.

RESPONSIBILITY

WMT is responsible for providing the services listed in the SCMR2020 description according to the local standard and the accurate description of services offered in its literature. WMT carefully selects and constantly checks its contract establishments such as hotels and restaurants. WMT is responsible for conscientious travel preparations.

WMT's liability for any damages is limited to gross negligence and willful intent. WMT is not liable for any traffic accidents. The kind of riding and choice of route is the sole responsibility of each tour participant, even when following the tour guide. This includes, but is not limited to, riding speed, riding style, operational maintenance and safety buffer distance between vehicles.

It is agreed and understood that any owners, operators and agents of SCMR2020 tour including WMT are not responsible for any participant's safety. WMT, its staff and volunteers, individually or collectively, cannot be held liable in any way for any occurrence in connection with the operation or the client's participation in connection with the tour, which might result in injury, death or other damage to the client, his property, or his family, heir, or assigns. The liability of WMT as the tour operator and event organizer is limited to a total of three times the tour price irrespective of the title/claim. WMT is not responsible for any delays, changes in schedule or other conditions. Women's Motorcycle Tours highly recommends the purchase of medical evacuation insurance.

RISK

The SCMR2020 participant is aware that motorcycle tours in addition to the usual dangers and risks inherent in travel have certain additional dangers and risks, such as, but not limited to, physical exertion for which you may not be prepared, weather extremes subject to sudden unexpected change, overcoming large altitude changes within a short

period, traffic rules, road conditions and the kind of local traffic which are not comparable with those they are accustomed to.

Each participant shall be aware of the risks and the inherent consequences and is accepting them with his/her tour booking without reservation.

SERVICE COMPLAINTS

SSCMR2020 Participants must inform WMT of any complaints immediately. If the participant fails to do so the complaint diminishes or becomes non-existent. The SCMR2020 participant is obliged to cooperate in case of lack of service and

damage to minimize the damages as much as possible. In order to handle any complaint, the participant must report it in writing no later than one month after tour completion.

TOUR PRICE ADJUSTMENT

Prices quoted in printed materials, over the phone or in person are those in effect at the time of printing or time of the quote. If cost factors, including but not limited to hotels, meals, motorcycles, insurance or international currency fluctuations

dictate the need for price increases, WMT may do so at any time prior to 60 days before tour departure. If there is an increase of more than 5% on the tour price, the participant will be entitled to cancel and receive a full refund.

INSURANCE

Women's Motorcycle Tours does not provide any medical, evacuation, travel or trip cancellation insurance. WMT recommends that you take out adequate travel, health and accident insurance as well as trip cancellation insurance. WMT recommends you have some type of roadside assistance service specific to motorcycles in addition to the above.

VERBAL CHANGES

Verbal changes of contract discussed with WMT, its representatives or tour guides are invalid unless confirmed in writing by WMT. Tour guides are not qualified for making concessions which are not in accordance with the terms and conditions of WMT.

ZERO POLITICAL MESSAGING

Women's Motorcycle Tours operates according to the ideals of unity, community, and the freedom of two-wheeled travels. All participants agree, in advance of the event, that they will not wear, brandish, or otherwise display any political messaging on the SCMR2020. WMT reserves the right to cancel any participant's involvement in the SCMR2020, with no refund or compensation, should participant display any such messaging. WMT is not and will not be liable for any expenses associated with any participant's expulsion from the SCMR2020.

INVALIDATION OF CONTRACT CLAUSES

If certain clauses in the contract become legally invalid, this does not mean that the whole of the contract is rendered invalid. The remainder of the contract shall remain in effect.

FUNDS IN TRUST

All funds paid to WMT for positions on tours are held in a trust account. They are held until the SCMR2020 commences, or are used only for costs directly related to it. Any refunds deemed necessary are limited to the individual's total funds paid in for SCMR2020 participation. If the funds are not sufficient to cover all claims, these will be satisfied proportionally. All claims from SCMR2020 participants must be reported within four weeks after the event. These funds are also held for WMT clients in case of the bankruptcy of WMT.
